

Inglewood Curling Club

Club Rules and Guidelines

Inglewood Golf and Curling Club is a member of Curling Alberta. All games will be played under the rules of the Curling Alberta including the 5-Rock Free Guard Zone rule.

Inglewood is a rental facility and is not responsible to manage any leagues. Individual ice costs and expectations of both the league and Inglewood will be discussed and outlined in a curling contract which will be signed by the league representative. It is the league representative's responsibility to communicate these expectations to their respective leagues.

Inglewood Curling Club Membership:

All persons wishing to register in a curling league require a current Inglewood Curling Club membership as outlined below:

- Non-Member (under 60) - \$50.00 + GST
- Non-member (60+) - \$35.00 + GST

MEMBERSHIP benefits are outlined below:

- Ability to spare in any league (abiding by applicable league rules)
- Free practice ice (based on availability, must be pre-booked)
- 15% discount on all curling supplies in the Pro Shop
- Club accreditation
- Support if representing Inglewood in sanctioned curling events
- Opportunity to participate in the Curling Alberta Club Championships representing Inglewood.

NEW- If you require a spare and they are not an Inglewood curling member, a “one-off” spare does not need to purchase an Inglewood Curling Membership. If a non registered curler would like to have their name added to a league spare list and spare in multiple leagues, they must register online and purchase an Inglewood Curling Membership.

Start Time:

Games must commence ***precisely*** at your designated ice time. Each league has a two-hour ice block. If a team does not commence play at the designated time:

- (a)** If the delay of the start of play is 1 – 15 minutes, then the non-offending team receives one point and will have last stone in the first end of actual play. One end is considered complete.
- (b)** If the delay of start of play is 16 - 30 minutes, then the non-offending team receives one additional point and will have the last stone in the first end of actual play. Two ends are considered complete.
- (c)** If play has not started after 30 minutes, then the non-offending team is declared winner by forfeit. The final score shall be recorded as 'W' and 'L' (win – loss).

Buzzer: NEW

The buzzer will sound 25 minutes before the end of your league's designated two hours. Finish the end you are on and play one more.

In order to keep the draw schedule on time, should the game run over the allotted two-hour ice time, the ice staff does have the authority to stop the game and remove the rocks in order to prepare for the next draw.

Proper Dress:

Curlers are required to be properly equipped and attired; especially with respect to footwear. Footwear can be curling shoes, running shoes or any shoe with a rubber sole (no heels). It is required that clean shoes be brought to the Club to be worn **only** while curling. No street shoes will be allowed on the ice.

Practice Ice:

Practice ice is designated for 1 hour.

Tuesday's between 12:30 – 3:30

Wednesday's between 12:30 – 3:30

Friday's between 12:30 – 3:30

Non curling members are required to sign a waiver and pay a drop-in fee of \$15.00 plus GST.

Days and times are subject to change weekly. All practice ice must be pre-booked. Please email Kathleen to book your practice ice curling@inglewoodgolfclub.ca

Curling Brooms and Equipment:

For safety reasons, curling brooms and equipment are not permitted in the lounge at any time. Please use the locker/change rooms to keep your curling gear, or the designated areas.
